



Background

In 1977 a group of surveyors in California met and agreed to form a new non-profit society not bound by any geographical boundaries. Their interest - the preservation of the history of the science of surveying. Their motivation - to form a society that would realize that purpose. Thus, the Surveyors Historical Society (SHS) was formed.

SHS hosts Rendezvous each year at locations throughout the United States to aid in the education and preservation of surveying instruments and surveying methods found in different areas. This also allows locals to showcase interesting survey-related projects and add an additional dimension to historic events or people found within their region.

A group met at the West Virginia Society of Professional Surveyors annual conference with a like-minded idea and formed the West Virginia Affiliate of Surveyors Historical Society (WVASHS) in 2000. From the onset this group has taken on projects relating to historical surveying which has been performed in or along the boundaries of West Virginia.



In 2009, WVASHS was selected to host a Rendezvous which was held in Cowen, WV. The focus of this Rendezvous was a County Line between Greenbrier and Harrison Counties surveyed in 1784 that stretched across the entire state from about Marlinton to the Ohio River.

WVASHS has been selected to host the 2022 Rendezvous being held in Harpers Ferry, WV. This memorable place, rich with both history and beauty, promises to make for a great location for the event.

The Rendezvous will touch on many subjects, including one of the numerous occupations of John Brown in the capacity of a surveyor and what it took for West Virginia, as the only state ever to be born out of war, to become a state. We will also explore some historical oddities which eventually led to the state's final boundaries. Finally, we will peek into the peculiarity of a couple other state boundaries and learn of the Supreme Court of the United States as being a court of original jurisdiction when relating to state boundary conflict.
